REDD + and SDGS

Manoa adopts a strategic approach aligned with the REDD+ mechanism (Reducing Emissions from Deforestation and Forest Degradation), which aims to encourage the conservation of tropical forests by promoting sustainable and responsible practices.

This international mechanism, created under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC), recognizes and rewards efforts that result in reduced greenhouse gas emissions from deforestation and forest degradation.

By integrating REDD+ guidelines into its operations, Manoa actively contributes to climate change mitigation, protecting valuable ecosystems, promoting the sustainable use of natural resources, and engaging local communities.

Furthermore, we are strongly committed to the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) established by the UN as a global agenda to achieve a more sustainable world by 2030.

Our actions are directly aligned with several SDGs, with emphasis on:

We promote educational activities that empower students and communities regarding the importance of environmental preservation and the responsible use of natural resources.



SDG 6 – Clean Water and Sanitation

We monitor rivers, springs, and our forest. Considering the High Conservation Value attributes, these locations have their preservation and maintenance as a priority, ensured through constant monitoring and surveillance, in addition to satellite image tracking.

We provide courses and training for employees and third parties:

- CIPA (Internal Commission for Accident Prevention) • Assessment for environmental certification
- Reduced Impact Logging • Basic first aid training • Prevention and firefighting of forest fires

SDG 12 – Responsible Consumption and Production



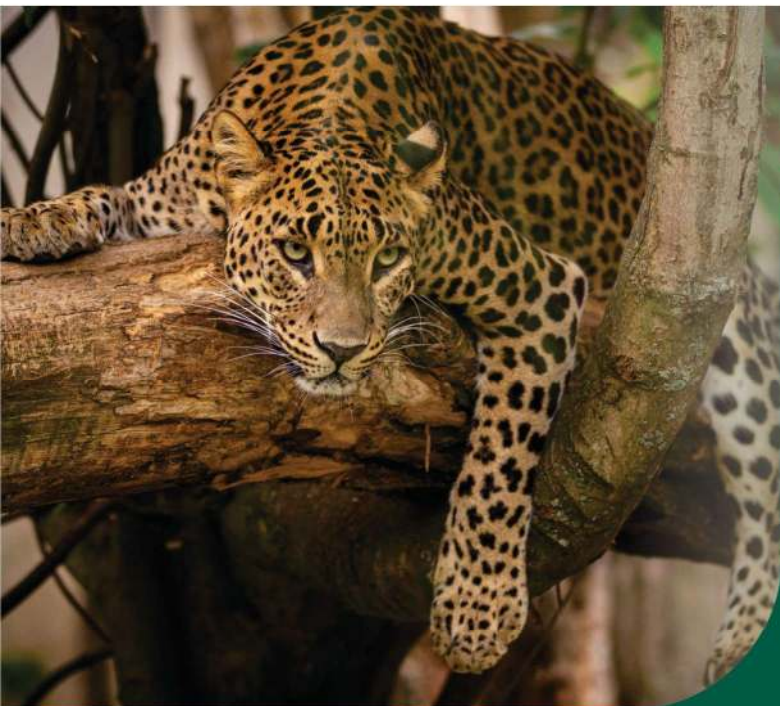
Our Chain of Custody ensures a safe and sustainable production cycle, from the harvesting of trees to the final product, at the industrial plant of Triângulo Pisos.
